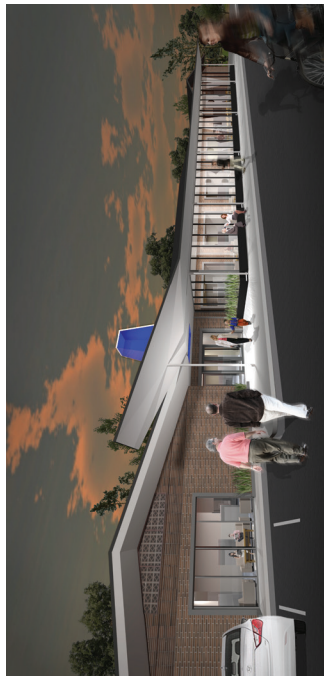

The Schweitzer Brentwood Branch Library, formerly Brentwood Branch Library, has been the neighborhood's library since 1971. The building resembles the nearby ranch-style homes of the time. Generations of patrons have developed a strong sense of pride in their neighborhood library, with the common claim of "That's My Library!" A tour of the project nearing completion will give attendees a behind-the-scenes look at the renovations, addition, and site development. Jim Schmidt, Associate Director of the Springfield Greene County Libraries, and Jason Hainline, Design Associate with Dake Wells Architecture, will provide insight into the design process.
